Golf Rule at KGC re Penalty Area Pegs

At KGC, pegs that mark boundaries of penalty areas are designated as immovable obstructions. If your ball is in a penalty area and a peg interferes with your stance or swing you are NOT entitled to free relief. (This also applies to such obstructions as the bridges over the "creek" on the 2nd and 8th holes and the retaining wall in front of the 8th green.) If your ball lies in the general area, you can take free relief if your stance or swing is affected by the penalty area pegs.
