



Kids Policy at Kiama Golf Club

At Kiama Golf Club we love having kids and young families in our club, but we do ask that you follow a few simple rules to make sure the club is comfortable for everyone to use.

- Children must always be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult whilst in the Kiama Golf Club, a responsible adult is a person over the age of 18yrs and either a parent, stepparent, or guardian of the minor.
- Children are not permitted to enter restricted/licenced areas of the venue (includes the gaming, bar and TAB area) if you are unsure of these areas, please ask our friendly staff to clarify these areas.
- It is an offence to supply children/minors' alcohol at any time, any person proven to be supplying minors with alcohol will be removed from the venue.
- Children under 18 are welcome in the club until 9.30pm with the exception of those children attending a private function. ➤ If children are attending a function within a designated function room, they are permitted to be within that room until the conclusion of the function.
- For the safety of all children shoes are to always remain on.
- The responsible adult should at all times ensure all children in their care behave in an appropriate manner whilst on club premises and refrain the child/minor from behaving in a manner that may cause other patrons' discomfort or inconvenience, such behaviour includes and is not limited to, swearing, fighting with other children, intimidating others, running around within dining & lounge areas.
