# WOMEN'S & MEN'S DRESS STANDARDS

The detailed dress standards required by Kiama Golf Club are displayed at the Pro Shop and within the Club House.

- No soiled clothing to be worn at any time
- Dress must be neat & tidy
- Collared or mock neck golf shirts for men
- Women's sleeveless tops require a high neck or collar
- Tops with sleeves need not have a collar
- Presentable shorts / skirts / slacks
- Not permitted singlet tops, bare midriffs, track or bike pants
- Covered footwear

**Metal spikes are NOT permitted**

## ETIQUETTE OF GOLF

1. The player on the lowest handicap shall be responsible for the proper observance of the etiquette of golf. If two or more players are equally handicapped, they shall share responsibility.
2. No one should move, talk, stand close to, or directly behind the ball or the hole when the player is addressing the ball or making a stroke. To speed up play, the honour may be taken by the first player ready to hit or preferably shorter hitters may play first. No player should play until players in front are out of range.
3. Slow play is selfish play. Be ready to play when it is your shot and walk quickly between shots.
4. Your group should keep up with the group in front. If your group falls more than a hole behind, or you are searching for a lost ball, you should call the players behind to play through.
5. Always enter bunkers at the lowest point. Some bunkers at Kiama have an entry apron. Before leaving a bunker, players should carefully rake and repair the bunker. Rakes should be left in the bottom of the bunker aligned with the direction of play.
6. Players must carry a sand bucket and ensure divot holes are repaired.
7. Players must ensure that when dropping clubs or the flagstick, no damage is done to the putting green. Players & caddies should avoid damage by standing too close to the hole in attending the flagstick. The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole. Spike & ball plug marks must be repaired before leaving the green.
8. To protect greens, their surrounds & tees, buggies must be kept to pathways where available.
9. When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the putting green. Marking of cards on greens or practising putting contributes to slow play. Player's buggies should not be left in front of the green but left to the side or near to the next tee.
10. Phones must always be on silent

# CONDITIONS OF PLAY

## LOCAL RULES

Local rules applying to all competitions are posted on the Board adjacent to the 1<sup>st</sup> tee and available through the MiScore App under “Local Rules”.

## COMPETITIONS

The Match Committee reserves the right to alter the programs, the method of play and the handicap divisions at any time. On the day of a competition, the names & times on the starting sheet become the time & order of starting by the committee. Players unable to attend or be punctual must notify the starter in advance. In Stableford or Par events, always pick up when you are no longer able to score on a hole.

## MARKING CARDS

All competition cards should be returned for record purposes. If incomplete, “NCR” should be written clearly on the card. A card marked “NCR” does not necessarily earn the player a handicap revision. Non-return of a card may be deemed as intent to protect your handicap. Competitors are responsible for checking, signing & returning their cards within 10 minutes of completion of rounds. It is the player’s responsibility to ensure that the correct handicap is recorded on the card. Players must record the number of strokes taken on each hole by each player, as well as placing a cross in the box for the players score.

The MiScore App is also available for use when scoring. The conditions stated above apply.

## MULTI-ROUND EVENTS

Players in multi-round events or “qualifying” match play events **MUST** indicate if they wish to or are available to continue playing in later rounds.

This should be done by placing a “YES” or “NO” on their card or entry sheet in the Pro Shop.

## MATCH PLAY

A schedule of times for completion of matches and any special points concerning the conduct of play will be placed on the notice board outside the Pro Shop prior to the qualifying round of a Match Play event.

## PROTESTS

A protest in connection with any competition or match shall be made to the Committee immediately upon completion of such competition. **All protests must be submitted in writing.**

## TIME SHEETS

Time Sheets are used for all events and can be accessed from the Member Portal or Pro Shop Kiosk.

No member is allowed to place more than four (4) names on the Timesheet.

Care should be taken by players when making alterations to their own place on the Time Sheet.

No alteration concerning another player is to be made without their prior consent.

On the day of the competition, please notify the Pro-Shop if you are not able to make the booked time.

Players should report to the starter 15 minutes before the indicated time.

Golf staff and/or men’s and women’s captains will determine the final order of tee off.

In Team Events, if you have to withdraw your name from the time sheet, you should notify the other players and attempt to find a replacement.

## HOLE-IN-ONE

A member achieving this feat in a competition round will have the ball used mounted on an engraved trophy. Members should obtain a form from reception, complete the form and hand to reception.

## **TRANSPORT ON THE COURSE**

Any member or visitor who wishes to use their own transport on the course must adhere to the process and procedure set out in our 'Private Golf Cart Policy'. A copy of this policy is available from reception; please contact the club for details or for a copy

## **PRACTICE ON KIAMA GOLF COURSE**

Guidelines for practice on Kiama Golf Course are:

### **Notify the Pro Shop**

Whether practicing on the course or practice range the Pro Shop must be notified for Insurance purposes.

### **Safety on Practice Range and Putting Green**

Players should be aware of others when using the practice facilities.

Be sure that other players are out of range.

No Drivers to be used on the practice range.

On the practice range all balls must be hit from the South to North end only.

Do not interfere with others on the putting green.

No bunker shots are to be played to the green while occupied by other players.

### **Consideration for Others**

When playing a practice round only 2 balls may be used.

Players must consider others on the course and the range at all times.

It is a player's responsibility not to hold up another player on the course.

Mobile phones must be on silent at all times.

### **Care of the Course**

Before leaving a bunker, players must carefully rake the bunker.

Replace the rake in the bunker facing the direction of play.

Repair all divots, ball marks or damage by shoes on fairways and greens.

Replace the flag stick with care.

Do not use the head of the club to remove ball from hole.

Local notices regulating the movement of golf carts should be strictly observed.

### **Failure to Observe Etiquette**

If a player consistently disregards these guidelines the Match Committee will consider taking disciplinary action against the offending player. In the case of a serious breach the Committee may restrict the use of the course by the player concerned.

## **APPLICATION OF HANDICAPS TO DIFFERENT COMPETITIONS**

**Individual Stroke, Par & Stableford** - Full Handicap

**4BBB (Stroke, Par or Stableford)** - Full Handicap

Please note that in Aggregate events that individual scores will be used for handicapping purposes

**Foursomes** - 1/2 of combined handicaps

Players hit from alternate tees & play alternatively with 1 ball

**Canadian Foursomes** - 3/8 of combined handicaps

Both players play from the tee, then play alternatively with the selected ball until holed

**American Foursomes** - 3/8 of combined handicaps

Both players play from tee, play a further shot with each other's ball before playing out with selected ball.

## **Ambrose**

4 Person - 1/8 of combined handicaps

3 Person - 1/6 of combined handicaps

2 Person - 1/4 of combined handicaps

A **maximum daily handicap** is in place for all Ambrose Events as outlined below:

- **Men 36, Women 45.**
- **Number of Drives** – 2-person team - 3 on front/ 3 on back  
- 3 person team – 2 on front/ 2 on back  
- 4-person team 3 drives each (can be on front or back)

## **Texas Team - Full handicap**

All 4 players hit off, best drive is chosen, all players then place their balls within 30cm and continue to play their own game until hole is completed. The best 2 scores on each hole are aggregated.

## **Match Play**

Full difference between handicaps

## **4 Ball Handicap Match Play**

Reduce the stroke play handicaps of all players by the handicap of the player with the lowest handicap, who will then play off scratch.

Each of the other three players is allowed the full amount of the resulting handicap.

The Match Play index is used to determine the holes on which handicap strokes are taken.

## **COUNTBACK SYSTEM**

For **tied scores in 18-hole nett competitions**, the following method is used:

(a) The best nett score over the last 9 holes.

Should there still be a tie:

(b) The best nett score over the last 6 holes.

Should there still be a tie:

(c) The best nett score over the last 3 holes.

Should there still be a tie:

(d) Count back hole by hole on net scores from the 18th hole.

(e) Gross scores will be used if the event is a gross event.

For **tied scores in 27, 36, 54 and 72 hole nett competitions**, the following method is used:

(a) The best nett score over the last 18 holes.

Should there still be a tie countback as above.

(b) Gross scores will be used if the event is a gross event.

## **For tied scores in Championship scratch events:**

A three-hole playoff, using holes 1,17 and 18 will be played with the player with the lowest total scratch score being the winner. If the scores are still even, play will continue over those three holes in a “sudden death” format.

## **For tied matches in Matchplay events:**

In the event of a tie after 18 holes the match will be decided by sudden death commencing from the 1<sup>st</sup> hole. Please notify Pro Shop staff to facilitate an immediate tee time.

## **4 BALL HANDICAPPING**

All cards in 4 Balls will be checked by the Match Committee in accordance with the criteria of Golf Australia and may be handicapped according to those directives.

## VISITORS

Visitors with “lifestyle” or “country” membership will only be permitted to play 5 games at Kiama Golf Club in the 12-month calendar period, January to December.

## SUSPENSION / CANCELLATION OF PLAY

A siren for suspension or cancellation of play will be activated from the match committee room by the match committee, duty person(s) or professional staff.

These signals will apply:

**Discontinue Play Immediately:** 1 prolonged note of the siren  
(Dangerous Situation)

**Resume Play:** 2 short notes of the siren, repeated

If the golf course is deemed unplayable to the members and the public, they are asked to mark their ball and take cover at the nearest appropriate refuge.

A decision will be made whether to continue, suspend or cancel play for the day, after evaluating the condition of the course and the projected incoming weather on the day.

## GRADES

In single events, the number of players determines the number of grades.

## TROPHIES

1. Trophy vouchers will be credited to a golfing member’s club account.
2. Thursday Pro Comp winnings credited to the pro shop account. Pro Shop credits expire after 150 days. Pro shop credits are non-transferable for member’s club account.
3. Visitors cannot win trophies in Closed Events. They are eligible for the Ball Competition only.
4. Visitors who win a trophy or a ball will have their prize credited to the Pro Shop. All visitor prizes must be drawn on the Pro shop.



5. Trophy vouchers (with the exception of Thursday & other nominated competition prizes) credited to a member's account must be used by 31<sup>st</sup> January coinciding with the end of the club's financial year.

6. In events the number of starters determines the trophy value.

## **RULES GOVERNING PGA/LPGA MEMBERS**

1. PGA /LPGA members must have a current GA Handicap to compete in Club events.

2. LPGA members can get a GA men's handicap.

3. Only PGA and LPGA members who have membership of Kiama Golf Club can play in "Closed Events".

4. A PGA/LPGA member can play in and win any nett event, including those that are "honour board" or "trophy" events.

5. PGA/LPGA members cannot win a Monthly Medal or play in the Gold Medal playoff. If these members win the nett event on a Medal Day the Runner up will receive the Medal.

6. PGA/LPGA members will be eligible for nett prizes only.

7. PGA/LPGA members **cannot** win NTP, Super Pin, Drive & Pitch, Longest Drive or Eagles Nest.

8. PGA/LPGA members are entitled to win a ball in the Ball Competition.

## **BALL COMPETITIONS & NEAREST TO HOLE**

Ball competitions and Nearest the Hole competitions are held in conjunction with all events.

Measurements for nearest the hole should be made carefully using a tape where possible.

The distance must be witnessed on the marker card at greenside.

A "Super Pin" will operate for Men and Women in nominated single events. Players must enter at the pro shop when collecting their card. Measurements for "Super Pin" should be made carefully and recorded on the allocated hole.

A "Super Six" will operate over 6 hidden holes when nominated for the days play.

## **GOLD MEDALS**

### **Men & Women**

Players who win a Silver Medal during the year play-off for the Gold Medal of the grade in which they qualified. A player who qualifies in more than one grade may have his/her score considered in each of these grades, but he may win only one Gold Medal. Handicaps will be a player's current handicap applying on the day of the Gold Medal play-off.

If a player has the best score in more than one grade they will win the medal of the higher grade.

## **INFORMATION APPLYING TO MEDLEY COMPETITIONS**

### **EAGLE'S NEST**

The Nest of balls will be awarded to any Kiama member who has an eagle during any Club competition round.

- The tee-markers must be in approximately normal positions (No temporary tees of greens)
- The Nest will not be in contention during Ambrose, Foursome, or other events in which the responsibility for playing the ball from tee to hole is shared. (Exception: Hole in One)
- A ball will be added to the Nest before the commencement of each Medley event up to a maximum of five per week.
- A member scoring a Hole in One is eligible to claim the Nest.
- If more than one player has an eagle during the same competition round, the Nest will be shared equally, with odd ball(s) being returned to the Nest.

## **Handicap Information**

### 18.0 NEW GOLFING MEMBERSHIP

- 18.1 Those persons joining the club as golfing Members are entitled to enjoy all social and golfing facilities of the Club.
- 18.2 New Golfing Members without a Golf Australia handicap are not entitled to enter or win a competition round of golf until such a time as they have
- (a) lodged three (3) handicap cards and obtained a Golf Australia handicap
  - (b) Their membership is approved by the board.
- 18.3 The 3 cards that are to be lodged MUST be played with & verified by another golfing member of the club.
- 18.4 After obtaining the three (3) handicap cards, the Member should hand them to a member of the Match Committee for the allocation of a handicap. If such a member is unavailable they should be handed in to the Pro Shop
- 18.5 When playing for a handicap in competition rounds, a Golfing Member will not be required to pay the entry fee nor will he be entitled to win any prizes. The member should inform the professional shop staff of the circumstances.
- 18.6 If a new Golfing Member has a current Golf Australia handicap, they are to supply details and confirmation of this handicap from their former club when lodging the membership form. Following confirmation of this handicap, the Member will be eligible to play in the Club's competitions.
- 18.7 Whether a new Golfing Member has a Golf Australia handicap or not, they may, outside of competition times, play social rounds of golf on the course and enjoy the other facilities of the club.
- 18.8 A new Golfing Member will be eligible to participate in all "in house" Club activities
